


Sawa Remote Counseling Sessions on Physical
Violence 2025




- There were **153** sessions related to **grief in the month of June 2025 – 183% higher than June of last year.**
- There were **582 venting and debriefing sessions**, 56% higher than June of last year: showing a continuous demand from callers for MHPSS support.
- Sessions related to **suicide ideation** jumped again by 23% in June compared to the previous month, with higher daily frequency and majority **severe.**
- June saw the highest number of sessions related to physical violence (227), where Sawa received **severe domestic violence cases.**
- Bedwetting** among children remained high at 47 sessions – **124% higher than June of last year.**
- From the beginning of 2025, Sawa has provided 147 sessions where issues related to children's speech difficulties were mentioned, including consultations with Sawa's speech therapist.
- Counseling sessions related to **fear and anxiety** came to 237 sessions, with an increase in sessions for the West Bank from last month by **87%.**
- Sessions increased from May to June for the Tulkarim (+61%), Hebron (+51%), Ramallah (+38%), and Nablus (+18%) governorates. Family conflicts were a prominent topic in the WB sessions.
- Sawa delivered 299 **remote medical consultations in June, 38 of which were for supporting callers in quitting smoking and dealing with their addictions.**
- Symptoms and topics discussed by callers during medical consultations this month included those related to **medications, fatigue, diarrhea, constipation, supplements, headaches, dizziness, and stomach-related symptoms such as vomiting blood and gastroenteritis.** More symptoms related to malnutrition as a result of the Israeli imposed blockade on material aid to the Gaza Strip.
